




# DIRECTIONS



The simplest way to locate Camp Valcrest is to query that name in your Google maps or similar GPS app. Alternatively, find Highway 2 which is also called the Angeles Crest Highway, and take this exit directly off the 210 Freeway in Los Angeles. From the exit then head up the mountain from La Canada along this scenic mountain drive. Camp Valcrest is located approximately 28 miles from La Canada and a large sign is visible on your left welcoming you to our historic camp. The drive typically takes about 40 minutes. Note: there are NO services like gas stations, restaurants, or cell service so be prepared. There *are* mile markers along the old Highway 2 which you will notice periodically. Camp Valcrest is located at mile marker 53.03. The elevation at Camp Valcrest is 6,000 feet above sea level and temperatures tend to be 15 to 20 degrees cooler than in the City of LA. Keep an eye out for wildlife along the way. Bears, deer, and other native animals including the unique silver foxes can often be seen.
